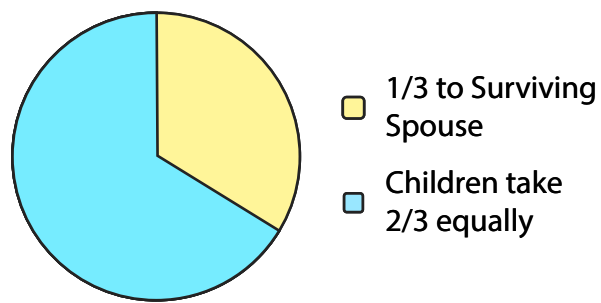
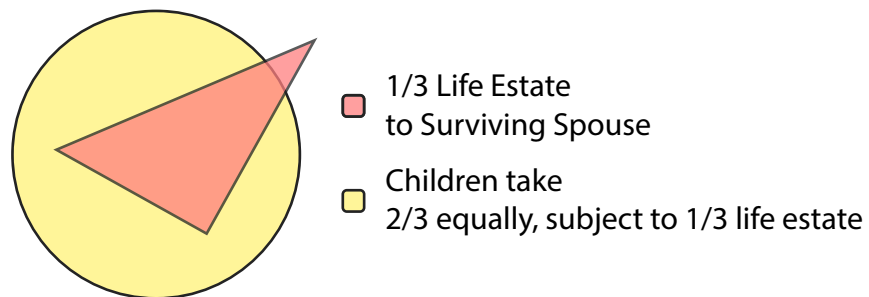


A. Decedent's SEPERATE PERSONAL PROPERTY

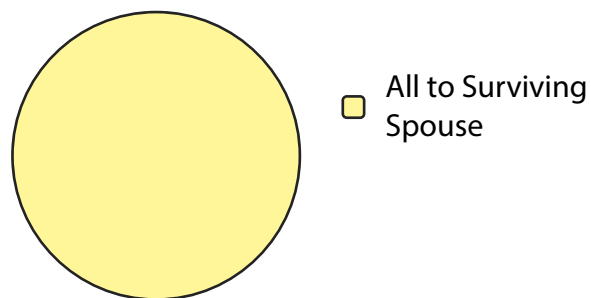


B. Decedent's SEPERATE REAL PROPERTY (owned before marriage or acquired during marriage through gift or inheritance)

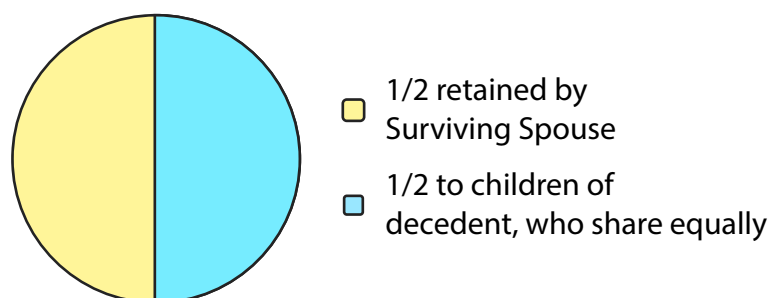


All separate real property will be owned outright by decedent's child(ren) or other descendants when surviving spouse dies.
